

Chinese as a Second Language COURSE SYLLABUS

GRADE LEVEL: 1 SCHOOL YEAR: 2023-2024

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COURSE DESCRIPTION:

In this beginning-basic Chinese as a second language course class is focus on having students master acquisition of the correct pronunciation and intonation, students are going to learn and practice basic skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing as well. Speaking and listening skills are the priority objective, which lead the acquirement of other skills of the language. Great emphasis will be placed upon standard pronunciation, listening comprehension; recognizing reading and writing by traditional Chinese characters; also, Chinese culture and customs will follow. This course will use a variety of supporting materials to provide students with an authentic and practical way to learn, while helping students to further study the language to lay a solid foundation.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

This course will help students develop and understanding of

- 1. Be able to master basic rules of Hanyu Pinyin.
- 2. Be able to differentiate the tones correctly.
- 3. Be able to speak basic greeting sentences.
- 4. Be able to write and read certain basic Hanyu Pinyin and tones correctly.
- 5. Be able to understand the basic concept of the Chinese language structures.
