## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This Chinese Language class is designed to increase learners' communication skills through listening, speaking, reading, writing and the study of the Chinese language and culture. Our primary focus in Chinese Language class will be mastery of pronunciation, reading, writing and the ability to express orally.

In this academic year, learners are expected to read dialogs in the textbook, a variety of short stories, children's folk rhymes and sing Chinese songs. Learners will experience Chinese culture throughout the lessons. Written assignments will be included with pinyin, Chinese characters and making simple sentences. Because of the nature of the community, work periodically in group situation and presenting information to peers in groups or individually, as well as in the authentic situation are also expected.

At-home reading, which is a component of our course, is expected. Learners will be held accountable for at-home reading by various methods.

# **LEARNING OBJECTIVES / OUTCOMES**

After successfully completing this course, learners should be able to:

## • 1<sup>ST</sup> QUARTER PERIOD

- Memorize pinyin system and basic syllabic structure of Chinese characters
- Know the radicals and follow the rules of stroke orders for writing Chinese character
- Recall a general idea of the uniqueness of Chinese grammar (no tense, word order, measure words, etc.)
- Learn to buy things and bargain in Chinese; be able to ask for permission/possibility
- Be able to describe an event; know how to use measure word 件(jian4)
- Describe weather & seasons; know how to explain one's preferences
- Perform Children's folk rhymes and Chinese songs
- Talk about the related Chinese stories

#### • 2<sup>ND</sup> QUARTER PERIOD

- Describe symptoms of illness; be able to use A-not-A and adj.-not-adj.
- Describe various campus facilities; be able to use 不但(bu2dan4)…而且(er2qie3)… (not only, but also)
- Discuss leisure activities and travel experience
- Perform Children's folk rhymes and Chinese songs
- Talk about the related Chinese stories

## • 3<sup>RD</sup> QUARTER PERIOD

- Count from 1-1,000 or more in Chinese
- Talk about Chinese festivals and foods; be able to explain an action happening during a reference of time in Chinese
- Know Chinese Zodiac; be able to use 而且(er2jie3) to give more detailed explanation
- Discuss hobbies with others; be able to use 過(guo4) to talk about past experience; use 一邊(yi4bian1)…一邊…to describe to simultaneous actions
- Perform Children's folk rhymes and Chinese songs
- Talk about related Chinese stories

## • 4<sup>TH</sup> QUARTER PERIOD

- Describe relative locations of buildings and various neighborhood; be able to use relational time structure…, 然後(ran2hou4)…
- Describe a-day event and achievement in sports; be able to use causal sentences
- Understand more about Chinese geography, history and historical figure
- Perform Children's folk rhymes and Chinese songs
- Talk about related Chinese stories

## **TEACHING STRATEGIES**

In order to provide a meaningful and authentic learning, different methods will be used throughout the course. The teaching strategies used as follows:

#### • Direct Instruction

- Other than textbook, the controlled and meaningful children's folk rhymes and related Chinese songs will be integrated in to class to enhance learners' Chinese ability.
- The usage of objects, charts, maps, tables, crafts, cartoons, short movies and other visual materials as to gain learners' interests in learning.

## • Differentiated Instruction

Differentiate texts, assignments, projects...etc., allow learners to learn in their own pace.

#### • Kinesthetic Learning

- Hands-on learning, allow learners to use multiple ways to learn, such as: drawing, role-play, drama, sports... etc.
- Game-based learning, practice Chinese through educational technology tools.

#### • Inquiry-based Learning

- Allow learners to ask questions and find out the answers through teacher's guidance.
- Use learners' Funds of Knowledge to develop more in-depth learning.

## • Expeditionary Learning

- Project-based learning, allow learners to put what they have learned in use.
- Develop the awareness of the authentic situation and problem-solving skills.
