COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is the advance level of the Chinese as a second language, it aims to help students naturally integrate into the profound Chinese culture through language research in terms of vocabulary, grammar, Chinese knowledge and communication skills. The simultaneous development of listening, speaking, reading and writing is especially emphasized. The designed is to help students develop skills to communicate in Chinese in authentic contexts and express their viewpoints appropriately, precisely, logically and coherently. The course also creates rich listening, speaking and expression and various reading and writing exercises for students who plan to take AP Chinese courses and exams.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

This course will help students develop and understanding of

- 1. Be able to use advanced words and higher-level grammar to express and communicate daily conversation.
- 2. Be able to correctly use high-ranking grammar to describe the process and results of events.
- 3. Be able to read short stories and read important news from newspapers.

- 4. Be able to base on ample illustrations or conditions to write different text types emails, letters, paragraphs and short essays.
- 5. Be able to deep understand contemporary Chinese characters, Chinese social developments, and the Chinese culture.
