#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

Religious Studies provides opportunities for students to develop integral formation. Thus, leading them to become valuable and constructive members of society by offering God-centered education and inculcating the Dominican ideals: love of study, prayer, community, and service to others.

The first graders embark on an exciting journey where students will understand and practice Universal and Christian values. They will reflect spiritually, think ethically, make good decisions, and grow in faith. We seek for students to develop deep knowledge, understanding and skills to grow according to God's will in the world around them.

Throughout the course students will enrich and nurture their spiritual development through prayer, faith formation and social sharing activities. Students will see and learn the beauty and goodness of creation, understand that Jesus wants to be their friend and that he welcomes everyone into his kingdom.

#### COURSE OBJECTIVES AND CONTENTS: SWBAT discover about:

**WORD:** Through the Sacred Scripture's reading and reflection, students will understand that God speaks and invites us to be more like Jesus. It will help them discover that listening carefully to the Scripture readings put us in touch with God and his plan for our lives. Learners will be able to identify that everything that surrounds us (family, school, and communities) will be impacted and leads us to a meaningful connection of love with one another.

The Scripture will help the children get more familiar with the Bible and take advantage of opportunities to read from it.

**WITNESS:** Students will understand that the mission of Christians is to help, love and serve others. Furthermore, they will realize how Church members care for one another, pray together, share, and help those in need. Through Jesus' example they learn how to act like the first Christians, open their hearts and minds of those around them to Christ. In the end, they will translate into action what they have learned from the subject.

**WORSHIP:** Enhancing faith formation will be reflected in our students' worship of God. Students will get familiar of the Church's liturgy and will enable them to participate more fully in the different kinds of prayers, including some of the prayers prayed by the worshiping assembly during the liturgy. Students will experience praying with God's word as a way of getting closer to Jesus and worship him by loving and serving others.
