COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Music Appreciation is a listening course and hands-on application of elemental composition and performance. Through listening, lecture, class discussion, and other activities, students will learn to listen to music to better and more effectively appreciate its skills. The class will begin with a unit on the essential elements of music, followed by how to play a chord progression on the piano or keyboard. This course will guide students in learning to compose and identify the keys of the music and the chords used. Students will also learn how to conduct a musical piece with the choir or ensemble.
