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#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

### Welcome to RS 1 Subject!

Religious studies seeks for an integral formation of the students to become valuable and constructive members of society by offering Godcentered education and inculcating the Dominican ideals: love of study, prayer, community, and service to others.

The first graders embark on an exciting journey where understanding and practicing Universal and Christian values become possible. They will reflect profoundly, think ethically, make good decisions and grow in faith. Students are expected to develop deep knowledge, understanding and skills to grow according to God's will in the world around them.

Reading strategies and providing real-life situations will allow students to expand their use of critical thinking.
