COURSE DESCRIPTION

In the fourth grade, students focus on meeting Visual Arts benchmarks for grades 3-5 by exploring various media and techniques. They develop motor skills, learn to apply visual techniques, symbolic language, and their art vocabulary through presentations and critiques. The course encourages creativity, critical thinking and problem-solving through diverse projects in drawing, painting, sculpture, and mixed media. Additionally, Art class integrates concepts from Math, Science, and Social Studies, while teaching students about the key components of art, including composition, subject, and content, as well as aesthetic perception, art criticism and cultural significance.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- This course will promote creativity, self-esteem, and self-expression, while it will also build children's critical-thinking and problem-solving skills; students will understand that there is no right answer sometimes; and will encourage student's own answers and decisions of what is "right" for them, increasing their degree of aesthetic appreciation and comprehension.
- We will follow through history in a chronological manner, learning from various artist' styles and masterpieces in order to learn different techniques and an appreciation of artwork; and will also use seasons and festivities (from all over the world) to enhance our projects.
- Art class will support academic content throughout all grade levels. A few examples
 just to name a few:
 - Math (patterns, shapes, symmetry)
 - Science (oil/water resistance, alcohol, salt and soap reaction to chemicals in paint, absorbing materials, animals and life)
 - Social Studies (artists and art from many different cultures, times and backgrounds)
- This course will also introduce students to the three components that define or make up a work of art: The composition, the subject and the content.
- Introduce students to different kinds of lines and how to use them (aesthetic perception)
- Introduce students to the basic steps to evaluate their own art work (Art criticism)
- Recognize the cultural purpose of artwork (Art History and Culture)
