COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The sixth-grade Language Arts course provides a balance of reading, writing, speaking, listening, and language skills. Vocabulary, spelling, and grammar assignments will be another important focus area in our class. Students will analyze different types of writing such as poetry, novels, short stories, and non-fiction. We will also practice writing persuasive, narrative, and informational essays. There will be an emphasis on proper grammar and style to produce accurate and colorful speaking and writing.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

By the end of the school year, students will be able to:

- analyze text structure and purpose through attention to the writer's voice and style as well as print and graphic features.
- plan, develop, revise, edit, and publish a drama script, informative, personal narrative, and argumentative essays.
- reflect on central questions or themes throughout the year about courage, perseverance, and empathy.
- step out of their comfort zones of grammar and vocabulary in order to grow as English users.
- analyze how two or more texts address similar themes or topics to build knowledge or compare the authors' approaches.
