COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Religious Studies fosters the holistic formation of young learners, guiding them to become constructive, God-centered contributors to society. Rooted in Dominican values—love of study, prayer, community, and service—this course nurtures both intellect and spirit.

Our first graders embark on an inspiring journey into Universal and Christian values. Through spiritual reflection, ethical thinking, and faith-centered decision-making, they grow in understanding and cultivate a meaningful relationship with God. They develop knowledge, insight, and skills that align with God's will in the world around them.

Throughout the year, students enrich their spiritual lives through prayer, faith formation activities, and communal sharing. They come to experience the beauty and goodness of creation, learn that Jesus desires friendship with each of them, and discover that His kingdom welcomes all.

COURSE OBJECTIVES: By the end of the semester, (SWBAT) Students will be able to:

WORD: Through the Sacred Scripture's immersion students will understand that God speaks and invites us to be more like Jesus. It will help them discover that listening carefully to the Scripture readings put us in touch with God and his plan for our lives. Learners will be able to identify that everything that surrounds us (family, school and communities) will be impacted and leads us to a meaningful connection of love with one another. The Scripture will help the children to become more familiar with the Bible and take advantage of opportunities to read from it.

WITNESS: Learners understand that the mission of Christians is to help, love and serve others. They will realize how Church members care for one another, pray together, share, and help those in need. Through Jesus' example they learn how to act like the first Christians, open their hearts and minds of those around them to Christ. They demonstrate by words, actions and behavior that what they experienced will help them reach others and bring them to Christ.

WORSHIP: Enhancing faith formation will be reflected in worship for our students.
