COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Welcome to Sacred Scripture course!

This course will help grade 10 students to focus on what it is that they desire in life and to wonder about what God desires for them. Through exploring God's Word, divine Revelation in Sacred Scriptures and in the teaching of the Church, it is hoped that students will begin to recognize God's purpose for their lives and trust in His love for them.

The Religious Studies course for grade 10 students is anchored on the three Pillars of the Campus Ministry Department namely: "Word" for Doctrine, "Witness" for the valuing and application of the concept learned, and "Worship" for the celebration of faith. The harmony of these three pillars will help to ensure holistic formation of the students.

WORD: Communicate a clear understanding of God's Word Revealed in Sacred Scripture recognizing one's aspiration to find meaning in life and communicating how Catholic teachings help them in their search for true happiness and fulfillment.

WITNESS: Articulate and apply the elements involved in good moral decision-making that are relevant in their lives as seniors; intensify the D' TORCH values along with the core values of Dominicans in response to God's call to live a moral life; develop community service initiatives/projects as a response to God's invitation to serve others (Matthew 25:40)
